A meeting of Departmental Academic Affairs Committee was held on 03/09/2019 at 10:30 a.m. in the office of HOD (Mech. Engg.) to deliberate on the application dated 13/08/2019 and moved by Molathoti Vinay Kumar (GME-1740881) with reference to the notice (Ref. No. SLIET/AS/4096 dated 06.08.19) and bearing a note of DR(Acad) for recommendation from DAAC therein.

The following observations have been made:

1. The applicant, Molathoti Vinay Kumar (GME-1740881) has to clear a total of seven subjects as mentioned in his application dated 13/08/2019. All these subjects belong to III semester as per applicable teaching scheme w.e.f. 2016.

2. Through above mentioned notice the applicant is advised to get registered in III semester

with junior batch (2018 batch).

3. As the applicant belongs to 2017 batch the subject required to be cleared are not available in the teaching scheme for III semester of 2018 batch and hence, it becomes impracticable for him to be registered in III semester with junior batch.

4. If the problem is resolved for this semester, similar problem will persist in subsequent

semesters for the applicant.

5. The submission, made further by the applicant through his application dated 03/09/2019 in response to some queries raised for further clarification in the meeting of DAAC, revealed that he (applicant) has to clear eight subjects in III semester and one subject each in I semester and IV semester.

Under this situation of the applicant and above all, study scheme (pursued by himthe applicant) being phased out, the Departmental Academic Affairs Committee feels that the norms for registration in V semester be relaxed enabling him to sail with his batch and clear his back log subjects in subsequent semesters subject to approval of the Senate.

## Minutes of the Meeting

A meeting of Departmental Academic Affairs Committee was held on 14/10/2019 at 12:30 p.m. and 22/10/2019 at 10:30 a.m. in the office of HOD (Mech. Engg.) to deliberate the application regarding permission for late registration in V semester for completion of M. Tech. thesis, and moved by Mr. Ranjan Kumar (Registration No. PGMSE/1750122).

The following observations have been made:

- Mr Ranjan Kumar (Registration No. PGMSE/1750122) has been pursuing M. Tech. dissertation/thesis under the supervision of Mr. Rakesh Kumar, Associate Professor (Mech. Engg.).
- The applicant reports that he had been ill and on bed rest for the period from 28.06.2019 to 30.08.2019 and the same is supported with medical documents.
- The applicant came to institute campus and submitted his application dated 06/09/2019 for permission to get himself registered in the next (current) semester to carry out dissertation and complete his thesis. The application was received in academic section on 11/09/2019.
- On 01/10/2019 the Associate Dean (Academic) sent back the file to HOD (ME) for recommendation of the guide concerned and DAAC (ME).
- The comment given by the supervisor concerned and based on status report of the student sought from the Coordinator, PG Dissertation on 03.10.2019 at np -3 indicates that the supervisor has not taken interest in the supervision.
- 6. Further, the comments made by the supervisor at np-4 on 10.10.2019 (in response to the direction given by the HOD (ME) to facilitate the work) also do not seem to be proper. The committee is of the opinion that the supervisor is expected to clarify the progress of the work, and how much additional time is required.

In the light of above observations the opinion of the committee is as follows:

- (a) The applicant should have registered in time, if not he should have informed the institute authorities of his problem in time.
- (b) The supervisor must have also been in touch with the scholar and must have advised him to deposit the fee in time.

As it is a matter related to the career of the applicant, the DAAC recommends for grant of permission to the applicant for registration in the current semester so that he may complete his dissertation and submit his thesis.

The DAAC views the behaviour of the supervisor to be unhealthy and suggests the Head of Department to take necessary action for maintaining healthy academic environment. The supervisor in this case shall be asked to clarify the following:

 The mid-term evaluation was carried out on 02/04/2019 and since then what effort was made by the supervisor to motivate/facilitate the scholar for expediting the work.

2. Why wasn't it reported by the supervisor that the student was ill and was taking treatment outside? Also, why the student was not advised to deposit the fee in time?

3. Why the supervisor is not aware of the progress of work being carried out by the scholar, and the file gets routed to the Co-ordinator, PG at np-3 on 03/10/2019?

A meeting of Departmental Academic Affairs Committee was held on 06/01/2020 in the office of HOD (Mech. Engg.) to deliberate the paper regarding year back & matching of courses (subjects) already completed in old scheme (by Mr. Vinay Kumar Molathoti, Regn. No. 1740881) with new scheme and received from DR (Acad).

The following observations have been made:

- The study scheme of 2017 batch (GME) and that of 2018 batch are entirely different. Hence, matching/mapping of subjects is not feasible.
- It is not clear from the notice bearing Ref. No. SLIET/AS 4755 dated 19/11/19 whether the student has to continue with his junior batch-2018 from 3<sup>rd</sup> semester onwards or for 3<sup>rd</sup> semester only as the student has cleared almost 4<sup>th</sup> semester.

In the light of above observations DAAC is of the opinion that it would be in the interest of student to allow him to continue in his own batch i.e. 2017 batch as a special case and clear back log subjects of 5<sup>th</sup> semester under self-study mode and those of 1<sup>st</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semesters through retest as the study scheme of 2017 batch, being not applicable for junior batch 2018 onwards, is phased out and which may invite other complexities.
