

Minutes of BOS meeting regarding updation of Information Brochure SET-2021

A meeting of BOS of Mechanical Engineering Department was held on 24.03.2021 in the office of HOD(ME) regarding updation of Information Brochure SET-2021

The qualification for various courses and syllabi was deliberated and following are proposed:

1. No change required in the syllabi for admission test to various courses.
2. No change required in the qualification for ICD Programmes, UG Programmes and PG Programmes.
3. Following eligibility criteria is proposed for admission in Ph.D Programme in Mechanical Engineering Department :

i. B.E/B.Tech./equivalent Bachelor Degree (declared equivalent by the corresponding statutory regulatory body), in relevant areas of Mechanical Engineering, with at least 60% marks in aggregate (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 60% to 55%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

and

ii. M.E/M.Tech./equivalent Master's degree (declared equivalent by the corresponding statutory regulatory body), in relevant areas of Mechanical Engineering, with at least 60% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 60% to 55%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.


