The qualification for various courses and syllabi was deliberated and following are proposed:

- No change required in the syllabi for admission test to various courses.
- No change required in the qualification for ICD Programmes, UG Programmes and PG Programmes.
- 3. Following eligibility criteria is proposed for admission in Ph.D Programme in Mechanical Engineering Department:
 - B.E/B.Tech./equivalent Bachelor Degree (declared equivalent by the corresponding statuary regulatory body), in relevant areas of Mechanical Engineering, with at least 60% marks in aggregate (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 60% to 55%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

11. M.E/M.Tech./equivalent Master's degree (declared equivalent by the corresponding statuary regulatory body), in relevant areas of Mechanical Engineering, with at least 60% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 60% to 55%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.
