Indian Researchers in Stanford University's Top 2% Scientists List for the Year 2020

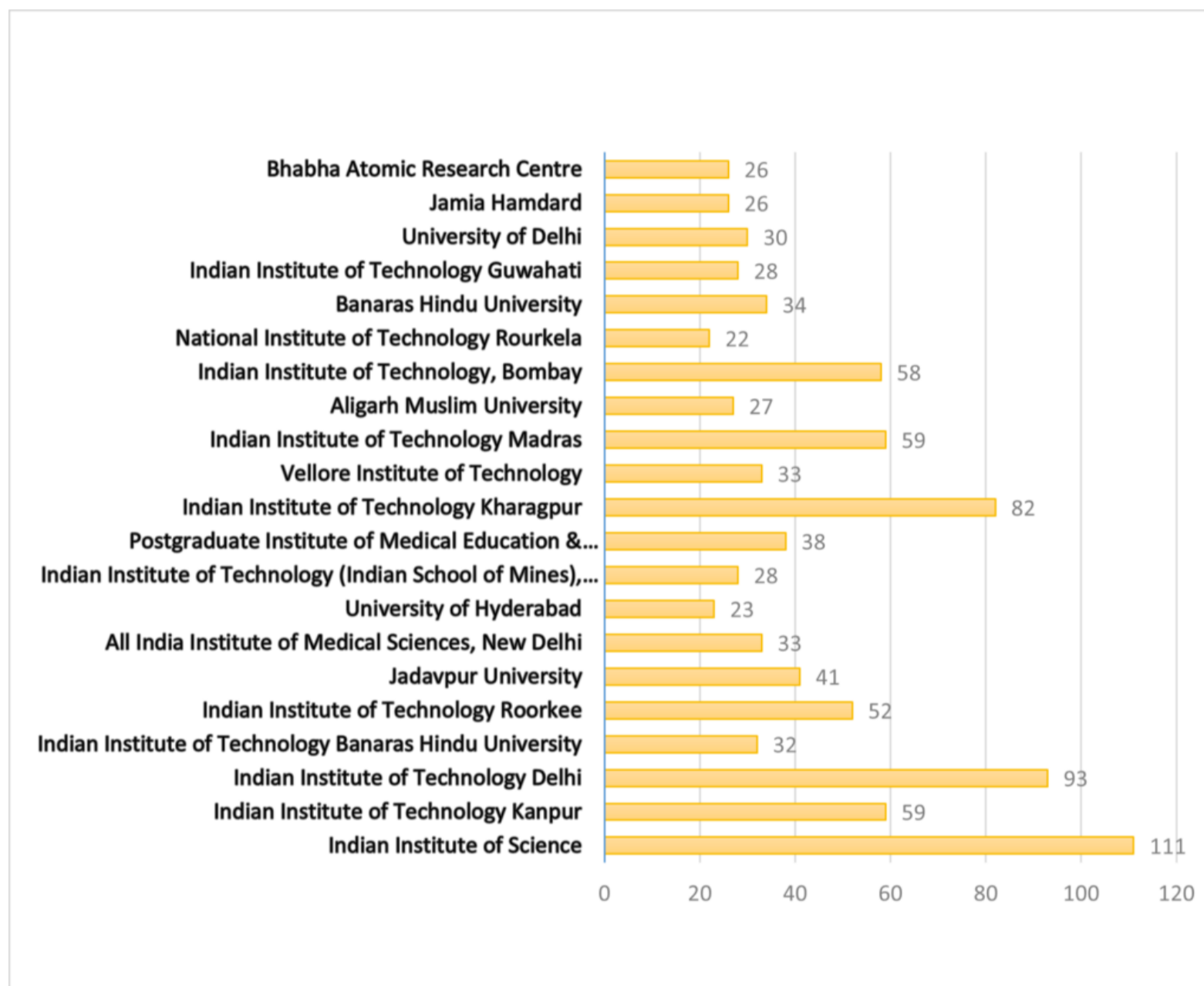


Figure 1: Top 2% most Influential Scientists with respect to the different universities from India

The results of a recent research performed by academics from [Stanford University](#), published a comprehensive list that identified the Top 2% most Influential scientists worldwide based on the [Scopus](#) publications impact [1]. The report was prepared by [Prof. John PA Loannidis](#) of Stanford University and his team [2] and published by Elsevier. Total 3352 Indian researchers found a place in this list that represents the valuable impact of India on the global research platform. Most of the researchers in this list are from the leading universities like [IISc](#), [IITs](#), [NITs](#), and [IIITs](#), etc [3-8]. Figure 1 represents the top 2% most Influential Scientists with respect to the different universities from India (only the universities where the number of researchers is more than 20 are shown here).

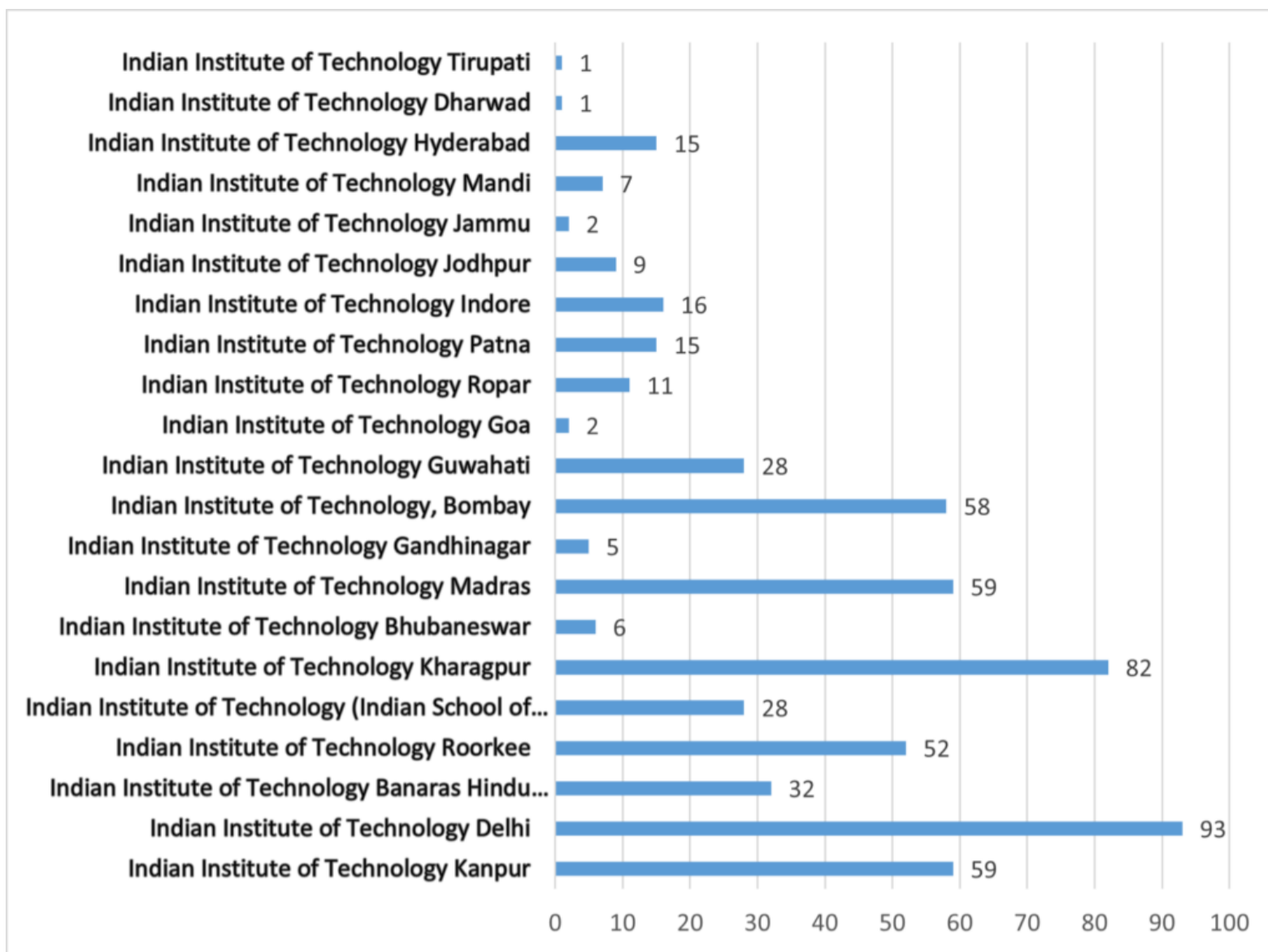
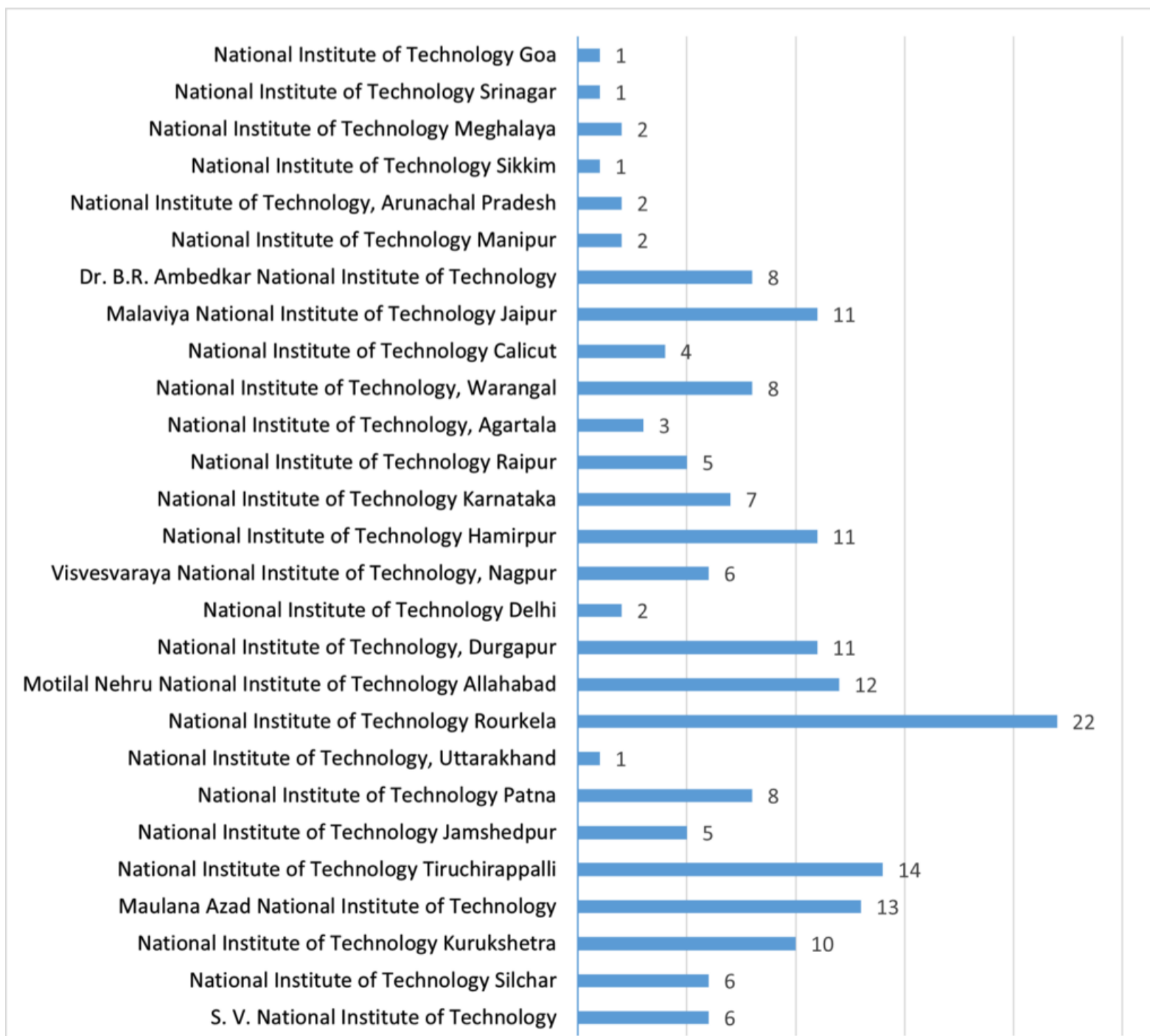


Figure 2: Top 2% most Influential Scientists from IITs.

Total 111 researchers from the [Indian Institute of Science \(IISc\), Bangalore](#) have found a place on this list, ranking it first among the higher educational institutes in the country followed by the [Indian Institute of Technology Delhi](#) with 93, and the [Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur](#) with total 82 researchers. Figure 2 represents the top 2% most Influential Scientists from IITs.

Figure 3 represents the top 2% most Influential Scientists from NITs. Total 22 researchers from the National Institute of Technology Rourkela have found a place this list, ranking it first among the NITs in the country, followed by the National Institute of Technology Tiruchirappalli with 14 and the Maulana Azad National Institute of Technology Bhopal with a total of 13 researchers.

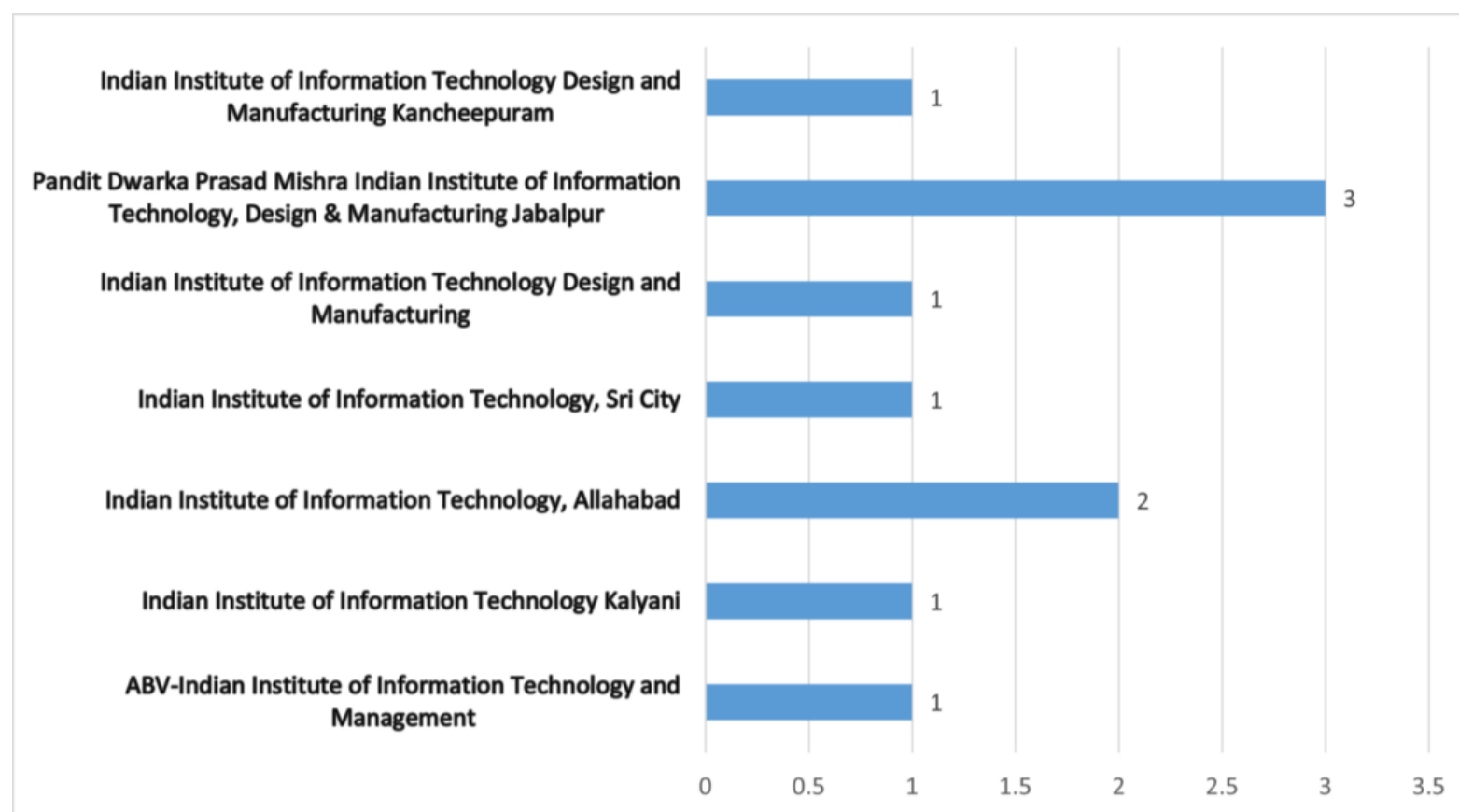


Figure 4: Top 2% most Influential Scientists from IITs

Figure 4 represents the top 2% most Influential Scientists from IITs. A total 03 researchers from the Indian Institute of Information Technology Jabalpur have found a place on this list, ranking it first among the IITs in the country, followed by the Indian Institute of Information Technology Allahabad with a total of 02 researchers.
