## Minutes of meeting of DAAC (Mechanical Engineering)

Case related to Mr. Gurbachan Singh, PGWLF/1850161, was examined in the DAAC's meeting held on 3.6.2022 in the office of HOD (ME) at 12.30 PM and the following was discussed:

Mr. Gurbachan Singh, PGWLF/1850161 had joined his job with Northern Railway while he was in his 4<sup>th</sup> semester due to which he could not submit his M. Tech. thesis. However, he has requested that he intends to complete his thesis work now. This entire case has been examined by the DAAC, and the following is observed:

- As per the Senate's decision taken in its 34<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 31.10.2018, and subsequently approved vide item no. 22.11, it is observed that as per the rule of early joining Mr. Gurbachan Singh can be granted ex-post facto approval for the same.
- 2. Mr. Gurbachan Singh in his request has stated that he was not aware of seeking prior permission from the institute before joining his job.
- 3. He has sought permission to get re-registered and has also give written assurance that he will be able to complete his thesis work by 30.6.2022, which is the last date of completion of his maximum tenure of four years for M. Tech. as per the PG rules of the institute. Further he has also given a written assurance through his supervisor DR. J. S. Gill, AsP (ME) that he will not seek permission for any kind of extension thereafter.

So, in view of this the DAAC (ME) recommends that in view of the precious time already invested by the student in coademic learning by virtue of pursuing his M. Tech. in the institute, Mr. Gurbachan Singh, PGWLF/1850161 may be allowed to complete his thesis work by reregistering himself for this course. However, he will have to strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under the provisions of the PG rules of the institute and his M. Tech: degree should stand completed in all respects within four years of his registration.
